



2011-2012 Lunchroom Guidelines

South Haven Public School provides our school with *their* lunch program. You will receive a menu every three months and your child will have a lunch account set up in their name so they may charge lunch or milk daily. When you send money for your child's lunch account please make your checks payable ***South Haven Public Schools***.

The following directives come from South Haven Public Schools

- ❖ Please do not let your child's account get up to the charge limit of \$15.00. South Haven Public Schools will not provide a free lunch if this happens. Account slips will be sent out when provided to the St. Basil school office by SHPS.
- ❖ Milk is provided with both hot and linco lunches.
- ❖ Preschool students may purchase Linco lunches only; they are self-contained and can travel safely to the preschool classroom.
- ❖ Extra milk costs 50 cents per milk, and students must have permission from parents.
- ❖ Only students who purchase **hot** lunches may take items from the salad or fruit bar.
- ❖ Linco lunches are self-contained; the salad/fruit bar is not included in the cost of the lunch.
- ❖ Students who qualify for free or reduced lunches may take extra milk but will be charged for that item. A bill will be sent home weekly. Parents must grant permission for any extra purchases.

If there are extra lunches left over, a second lunch will be available for purchase to students in grades 5th-8th. Parental permission is needed for the extra charge to your child's account.

Lunchroom Behavior

- Be courteous
- Speak in quiet voices
- Ask permission to leave your seat
- Clean up your surroundings
- Listen to our parent volunteers and our food service tech from South Haven Public Schools
- Parents, please reinforce our lunchroom behavior rules at home.

Food Allergies

- Doctor slips are needed for any medical conditions regarding food allergies. Allergies are not considered a medical condition unless a doctor slip is provided. *Please inform the food service tech of any known allergies.*
- **We have a peanut allergy in the school. Please speak to your child about the important safety issue of not sharing food. We may also ask your child to move their seat for safety reasons if they have an item containing a peanut product. The classroom teacher may request peanut free snacks.**
